Throughout my career I have been a part of 500 victories as both a head and assistant coach. I began my journey at the Division I level under John Calipari, playing a vital role in the revival of basketball at the University of Memphis culminating in a Conference USA championship and an NCAA appearance in 2003. Following my time there, I earned unprecedented success at the high school level, achieving an overall record of 353-91 on my way to 3 State Association Championships. In 2003, I reconnected with my old high school coach Wes Henning as Associate Head Coach at Ridgeway High School. Together, we revitalized the program and went to 3 straight TSSAA Championship games. I took the helm at Memphis Melrose High School and won the TSSAA Championship in 2010. In six years as a high school basketball head coach, I coached 26 high school senior student athletes and all 26 of these young men earned basketball scholarships. I returned to the Division I ranks as an assistant at Georgia Southern, and recently accepted a position under Heath Schroyer as an assistant at Tennessee-Martin. I have the leadership qualities, experience, and energy to reinvigorate a collegiate program.
